MEDIA ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES



The Giru di Corsica - Tour de Corse is the 11th round of the FIA European Rally Championship and has to apply to strict criteria for media. Please read the following guidelines carefully and make sure all the information requested is supplied with your accreditation. Incorrect and/or incomplete Forms may not be considered.

The accreditation is envisaged for:

- Journalists
- Media photographers

Accreditation is not envisaged for advertising, marketing or public relations agencies, media representatives, who are not journalists, photographers or video cameramen, as well for representatives of teams or sponsors.

FIA ERC Permanent Press Credential holders do not need to apply for event accreditation but are required to email helene.lariviere@free.fr and media@fiaerc.com confirming their attendance.

ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES

A maximum of three (3) representatives per organisation will be considered for a accreditation. A separate application form should be submitted for each person to be accredited.

A publication must have a circulation size and quality that satisfies the criteria of the Organiser and Eurosport Events.

INFORMATION TO BE SUPPLIED WITH EACH APPLICATION

An accreditation request on the publication's official letterhead, signed by the Managing Director or Editorial Chief. Any request signed by clerical staff will not be accepted.

A photocopy of the official national press card of the representative who will be covering the event.

General information about the publication, such as frequency, circulation or readership figures.

A current and original copy of the publication.

A formal letter of intent stating the publication's commitment to publish a piece on the Giru di Corsica - Tour de Corse 2014 and a possible publication date.

A completed accreditation form.

Once applications have been processed by the Giru di Corsica - Tour de Corse Rally Media Team and approved by Eurosport Events, an email confirming successful accreditation will be sent to the applicant(s).

This confirmation email must be produced when signing on in the Media Centre. You will not be able to sign on without this email.
